- Aburi is located in in the Akuapim South Municipal District of the Eastern region of South Ghana about 30 minutes from the Accra Mall
- Aburi is 30 km north east of Accra via a modern highway
- The driving distance between Kotoka International Airport in Accra to Aburi is approximately 45 minutes
- The Amistinea Estate site is on the mountain side with a lush expanse of greenery and vegetation so this provides some amazing views of the landscape
- Due to the altitude of Aburi, the weather is a lot cooler than neighboring Accra
- The population of Aburi is over 18,701 as of 2013
- Aburi is a major cocoa trading hub

Aburi is famous for the Odwira Festival. This festival is celebrated by the people of Akropong-Akuapim, Aburi, Larteh and Mamfi in the Eastern Region during the months of September and October. Odwira is a time of spiritual cleansing. Those who celebrate it, present themselves anew and pray for protection. Traditionally, the timing of the festival also coincides with the harvest season when food is abundant. People give thanks to the ancestors for paving the way for them.

Aburi is home of the finest wood markets, the Aburi Craft Village, which has around 120 shops dealing in wood and textile art. The art pieces are exported all over the world. Woodwork is one of the biggest industries of the region.
